

# FROM PASTOR DAN

"But on the first day of the week at early dawn, the women came to the tomb taking spices they had prepared. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in, they did not find the body." (Luke 24:1-3)



Don't you just love surprises? Birthday surprises! Christmas surprises! Surprise parties! Surprise visits from people you love who you haven't seen in a while! We can think of all kinds of things that are fun surprises that bring joy and excitement to our lives, can't we? I mean, life is filled with them!

The women, I'm sure were surprised when they arrived at the tomb...to find that Jesus was missing. But what kind of surprise do you think it may have been for them? Was it a good surprise? A cautious surprise? A disappointing surprise? A "what is God up to now?" kind of surprise? It seems to me that they don't know what to think about this situation! Put yourselves in their sandals for a moment...what kind of surprise would you envision this would have been for these women? We aren't really told. I mean...what would you have thought if you were there?

How has God surprised you by things he has done in your life lately? What kinds of things has he done in your life to make you wonder, "what is God

up to now?", because you can't decide if it is something good or something not so good! Kind of like these women. They didn't really know what to think at this point. I think we all can understand their confusion.

You know...God surprises us in many ways as he works in us and through us each and every day. God does things to make us wonder, "how did that happen?" God does things to make us wonder just how he is working in positive ways in the midst of some not so positive things happening in our lives! He surprises us as we experience our faith and our lives together.

We are blessed to live on this side of the resurrection. We know how the story of Jesus turns out. We know how his story continues through us each day, touching lives with his love and forgiveness and hope. And even then, God surprises us sometimes.

In just a few short weeks, Easter will be upon us! And we will be celebrating the joy and hope of Jesus' resurrection! But here's the thing...though the actual "surprise" may be gone, the joy and hope and celebration of the resurrection becomes new for us every year! It's a time of renewed hope of what Jesus did for us. It's a time of renewed love for one another. It's a time of renewed promise of eternal life provided for us through the resurrection!

# FROM THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY

During the month of February 2024, we received Tithes and Offerings from 54 families. In any given month, the number of families contributing is usually more in the range of 65 to 75 families. Our goal for meeting the Mission Plan needs this month was \$ 20,202. Our actual Tithes and Offerings totaled \$ 19,587, leaving us with a deficit a little over \$600 for the month. We know that January and February are slow months for us and we anticipate that we will return to more normal levels in the coming months.

Two highlights this past month were the Polar Plunge and the Rice Bowl offering. The KMLC community members and friends contributed a little over \$1,000 - This covered our Sponsorship donation to New Hanover County Special Olympics. Our Rice Bowl collection brought in \$298 for the Coastal Therapeutic Riding Program. Our donation will help them offer grants to needy clients, unable to pay for their services. A great big Thanks goes out to all who shared their resources to help these programs succeed.

Joy Harjo (Mvskoke, Tulsa, Oklahoma) is the United States Poet Laureate. Singer, saxophonist, poet, performer, dramatist, and storyteller are just a few of her roles. Somewhere between jazz and ceremonial flute, the beat of her sensibility radiates hope and gratitude to readers and listeners alike. For example, from Harjo we learn that the opposite of love is not hate, but fear. Several of her books, such as How We Became Human, The Woman Who Fell From the Sky, and She Had Some Horses are now classics in both English and World Indigenous Literature. Harjo has recorded five original albums, including the outstanding Winding Through the Milky Way with which she won the 2009 Native American Music Award (NAMMY) for Best Woman Artist of the Year. This poem, FIRE, is from her book, Conflict Resolution from Holy Beings (2015).

### **Fasting During the Lenten Season**

As we reflect during the Lenten Season, let pause and think about where we are and on where we want to be in 40 days. Traditionally, various religions encourage believers to "give up" things for Lent.

While this may lead to inner purification, we might also turn outward - replacing negative habits with positive action.

Let us pray that as we begin the season of Lent we embrace the opportunity to:

Fast from judging others; Feast on Christ dwelling in them. Fast from fear of illness; Feast on the healing power of God. Fast from anger; Feast on patience.

Fast from pessimism; Feast on hope.

Fast from negatives; Feast on encouragement. Fast from bitterness; Feast on forgiveness and joy.

Fast from suspicion; Feast on truth.

Fast from gossip; Feast on purposeful silence.

Fast from problems that overwhelm; Feast on prayer that sustains. Fast from anxiety; Feast on faith.

Fast from hurting words; Feast on kind words.

Fast from sadness and discontent; Feast on gratitude.

Fast from anger and be filled with patience.

Fast from worries; Feast on trust in God.

Fast from complaints; Feast on simplicity.

Fast from selfishness and self-concern; Feast on compassion for others.

Fast from grudges Feast on reconciliation.
Fast from words; Feast on silence and listening.

We pray that, this Lenten season, our only desire and our one choice is to choose what better leads to the deepening of God's life in us.


We ask God to guide our decisions today and help us share God's peace, joy and love with others. Amen.






